## **Annotations**

### **1. Election of officers**

Rule 15 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council stipulates that, at the commencement of the first meeting of a regular session, the Commission shall elect from among the representative of its members a Chairman, one or more Vice-Chairmen and such other officers as may be required.

At most of its past sessions, the Commission has elected a Chairman, three Vice-Chairmen and a Rapporteur or Vice-Chairman-cum-Rapporteur.

### **2. Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters**

Rule 7 of the rules of procedure requires that, after the election of its officers at the beginning of each session, the Commission shall adopt the agenda for that session on the basis of the provisional agenda.

### **3. Follow-up to the World Summit for Social Development**

In accordance with the Twenty-fourth Special Session of the General Assembly entitled "World Summit for Social Development and Beyond: achieving social development for all in a globalizing world", the Commission will undertake regular assessment of the implementation of the Copenhagen commitments and the further initiatives adopted at Geneva.

#### **(a) Themes:**

**(i) Priority theme: enhancing social protection and reducing vulnerability in a globalizing world**

**(ii) Sub-theme: the role of volunteerism in the promotion of social development**

As decided at the thirty-eighth session, the Commission will have before it reports of the Secretary General on the priority theme and sub-theme.

#### **(b) Review of relevant United Nations plans and programmes of action pertaining to the situation of social groups.**

The Commission will consider issues pertaining to the situation of social groups. The Commission will have before it reports of the Secretary-General on the follow-up to the International Year of Older Persons and the follow-up to the International Year of the Family and the observance of its tenth anniversary in 2004.

In accordance with General Assembly resolution 54/262, the Commission will serve as the preparatory committee for the Second World Assembly on Ageing. The Bureau of the Commission has proposed that the Preparatory Committee will take place from 26 February to 2 March 2001.

#### **(c) United Nations Research Institute for Social Development**

##### **Nomination of members of the Board of the Institute**

The Board of the United Nations Research Institute for Social Development is composed of 10 members who are nominated by the Commission for Social Development and confirmed by the Economic and Social Council for a term of four years, renewable once for a further two years, in accordance with Commission resolution 10 (XXV).

The Commission, at its thirty-ninth session, will therefore be called upon to nominate a number of new members and to renominate some existing members of the Board. The Council will be called upon to confirm those nominations in 2001.

##### **Report of the Board of the Institute**

In accordance with its terms of reference, the Board of the Institute submits to the Commission a report on the progress of its work. The report before the Commission covers the biennium 1999-2000.
